

Best of Breed ... Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. In addition, the Winners Dog and Winners Bitch together with any undefeated dogs that have competed at the show only in additional non-regular classes.

Non-regular Classes Involving Single Entries

Veteran Dog Class For dogs 7 years old and over. Veteran Bitch Class For bitches 7 years old and over.

Non-regular Classes, Involving Multiple Entries

Stud Dog Class ... For Stud Dogs and a minimum of two and maximum of three of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes. Or if a Champion of Record, in the Best of Breed Competition, but MUST be entered in the Stud Dog Class. The Get MUST be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

Brood Bitch Class ... Same as for Stud Dog, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Brace Class ... Two dogs of the same Breed with identical ownerships. The dogs are not required to be entered in a regular class.

Team Class ... Same as Brace Class, except substitute 4 dogs for 2 dogs.

Schipperkes on Parade ... Dogs entered in this class may or may not be entered in a regular class. Dogs need not be holder of an AKC title. A Class Streamer Rosette with the dog's name will be awarded.

Parade of Castaways ... Dogs entered in this class may or may not be entered in a regular class at this show. These dogs are Schipperkes of any age, with or without papers, who were obtained through adoption from an original owner, known or unknown, who couldn't or wouldn't keep them. A Class Streamer Rosette with the dog's name will be awarded.

Best of Breed - Dara Wilcox and Betty Liittschwager offer the "Ch. Blue Max's Johnny Jump-up" Challenge Trophy. For permanent possession, it must be won three times by the same owner, not necessarily with the same dog. The trophy is a bronze Schipperke on a wooden box with a Captain's Wheel. It will be adorned with a brass plate on which the year, dog's name and owner's name are to be engraved. A small "Captain's Wheel" will be offered by SCSC as a token trophy.

Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed - Members of SCSC offer a challenge trophy. For permanent possession, it must be won three times by the same owner, not necessarily with the same dog. The trophy is a Silver-Plated Candelabra. It will be adorned with a brass plate on which the year, dog's name and owner's name are to be engraved. It is to remain in the possession of the Club until it is retired. A Candle Holder will be offered by SCSC as a token trophy.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP ~

•Novice Junior Class: For boys & girls who are at least 10 yrs & under 14 yrs on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won 3 First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed/member show. •Novice Senior Class: For boys & girls who are at least 14 yrs & under 18 yrs on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won 3 First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed/member show. Open Junior Class: For boys & girls who are at least 10 yrs & under 14 yrs old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won 3 First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show. Open Senior Class: For boys & girls who are at least 14 yrs & under 18 yrs old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won 3 First Place awards with competition present in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show. •Each dog handled in a regular Junior Showmanship Class must be entered in one of the Breed or Obedience Classes at the show, or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. However, a dog may be substituted. Such substitution must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form. All such substitution must be made one half-hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship Classes at the show. Each dog must be owned or co-owned by the Junior Handler or by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather, grandmother, including step and half relations or by a member of the Junior Handler's household. Every dog entered for Junior Showmanship must be eligible to compete in Dog Shows or Obedience Trials. Bitches in season are not eligible. A dog that has been excused or disqualified by a Breed Judge or by a Bench Show Committee may still be handled in Junior Showmanship if eligible to compete in Obedience Trials. A dog that has been rejected, dismissed, or excused by the Veterinarian for the protection of the other dogs at the show or for the protection of the dog excused may not be handled in Junior Showmanship.

•Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class, with competition present, after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent /Show Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging or one half-hour prior to the start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier.

•Winning of first place in an Open Class at this show may qualify or count toward qualification for entry in certain future limited Junior Showmanship Classes. For information on eligibility requirements for limited Junior Showmanship Classes, which have been approved to date by AKC, write to the American Kennel Club, Show Plans, 5580 Centerview Dr., Suite 200, Raleigh, NC 27606.

•Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler Identification number on the entry blank. You may obtain your number by calling the AKC (919)854-01361. **Notice**: Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form.

MEET OUR JUDGES ~

CONFORMATION JUDGE: MRS. CAROL A. WILLIAMS

Carol Williams purchased her first Bulldog in 1961, she had not only never owned a Bulldog, she had never even seen one. She called an ad in the paper and asked the nice lady if she could just come and see what a Bulldog looked like. She came home with a pet bitch. Carole had been told that she was not show quality, so she thought she would train her in obedience. Never having been to an obedience trial, she didn't know anything about obedience and neither did "Sissy" but they graduated at the top of their class. Their class was run by a lady in their small town who had learned about obedience training through a book. Since Carol felt something should be done with all this new found knowledge, she and "Sissy" entered a two-day obedience specialty show. They did not know until they were in the ring that there was an exercise called "off leash". "Sissy" enjoyed it a great deal as she got to snoop under the stewards table and ham it up for the ringside spectators who were laughing hilariously while Carol did the obedience exercise perfectly by herself. "Sissy" managed to get her CD, but Carol has never trained another Bulldog in obedience.

Since that inauspicious beginning, Carol has always had Bulldogs and has bred many champions, multiple group winners and one BIS dog who was #2 Bulldog in the US, with only showing in her area, for two years in a row.

She added Brussels Griffons to her family in 1978, and bred several champions in that breed with one of her favorites being a bitch who finished her championship and her CD on the same day.

In 1994, after two years of studying and searching, she got her first Cavalier King Charles Spaniel. When Cavaliers were recognized by AKC, her girls rapidly got their championships and since then she has bred several more Cavalier champions, but Carol feels the real forte of the Cavaliers is in being the wonderful pets and companions that they are. Today Carol still has Bulldogs, a Brussels Griffon and several Cavaliers. All her guys get along together and play together and it is really funny to see the little Cavalier bitches whipping the Bulldog males into shape.

Carol was approved to judge Bulldogs and Brussels Griffons in 1988 and considers herself very fortunate to now be approved to judge the Non Sporting and Toy Groups. Dogs and all the related activities have been her life. She has long had an appreciation for all breeds of dogs and has found that if you want to learn more about your own breed, you need to learn about other breeds as well. Judging has been Carol's joy and she is especially pleased to be able to judge at this specialty show.

OBEDIENCE JUDGE: MRS. SHIRLEY INDELICATO

Shirley Indelicato is totally involved in all aspects of the dog fancy, as a breeder, conformation and obedience exhibitor, and approved judge for all obedience classes.

She began formal obedience work in 1957 by training a very strong-willed poodle puppy by first reading Blanch Saunders book and then going outside and working the dogs from what she had learned. After completing the Novice degree and having learned about "obedience classes", she enrolled in advanced training classes, subsequently earning a Utility on the "impossible puppy".

Since then Shirley has trained several poodles through various American and Mexican degrees, with several Will Judy awards and 200 scores. Some of these poodles were shown in conformation as well and have earned AKC Certificates of Championship. She trained her German Shepherd, Ch. Heidi Ho of Ranier, CDX, PCE, receiving dual awards.

Shirley is a great believer that conformation and obedience not only can co-exist, but can complement each other. Her "Delsen's" poodles breeding program has produced some outstanding working poodles as well as conformation specimens. Many of them have also achieved obedience championships, Will Judy Awards and 200 scores.

Her judging career, which began with AKC approval in 1971, has not only included many AKC trials throughout the country, but also five Gaines Regional Championships in Florida, New Mexico, Utah, California and Nevada.



Schipperke Breed Standard

General Conformation

General Appearance

The Schipperke is an agile, active watchdog and hunter of vermin. In appearance he is a small, thickset, cobby, black, tailless dog, with a fox-like face. The dog is square in profile and possesses a distinctive coat, which includes a stand-out ruff, cape and culottes. All of these create a unique silhouette, appearing to slope from shoulders to croup. Males are decidedly masculine without coarseness. Bitches are decidedly feminine without overrefinement.

Any deviation from the ideal described in the standard should be penalized to the extent of the deviation. Faults common to all breeds are as undesirable in the Schipperke as in any other breed, even though such faults may not be specifically mentioned in the standard.

Size, Proportion, Substance

Size--The suggested height at the highest point of the withers is 11-13 inches for males and 10-12 inches for bitches. Quality should always take precedence over size. **Proportion--**Square in profile. **Substance--**Thickset.

Head

Expression—The expression is questioning, mischievous, impudent and alert, but never mean or wild. The well proportioned head, accompanied by the correct eyes and ears, will give the dog proper Schipperke expression. **Skull**—The skull is of medium width, narrowing toward the muzzle. Seen in profile with the ears laid back, the skull is slightly rounded. The upper jaw is moderately filled in under the eyes, so that, when viewed from above, the head forms a wedge tapering smoothly from the back of the skull to the tip of the nose. The stop is definite but not prominent. The length of the muzzle is slightly less than the length of the skull.

Eyes The ideal eyes are small, oval rather than round, dark brown, and placed forward on the head.

Ears—The ears are small, triangular, placed high on the head, and, when at attention, very erect. A drop ear or ears is a disqualification. **Nose**—The nose is small and black. **Bite**—The bite must be scissors or level. Any deviation is to be severely penalized.

Neck, Topline, Body

Neck--The neck is of moderate length, slightly arched and in balance with the rest of the dog to give the correct silhouette. **Topline**--The topline is level or sloping slightly from the withers to the croup. The stand-out ruff adds to the slope, making the dog seem slightly higher at the shoulders

than at the rump. **Body**--The chest is broad and deep, and reaches to the elbows. The well sprung ribs (modified oval) are wide behind the shoulders and taper to the sternum. The fore chest extends in front of the shoulders between the front legs. The loin is short, muscular and moderately drawn up. The croup is broad and well-rounded with the tail docked. No tail is visually discernible.

Forequarters

The shoulders are well laid back, with the legs extending straight down from the body when viewed from the front. From the side, legs are placed well under the body. Pasterns are short, thick and strong, but still flexible, showing a slight angle when viewed from the side. Dewclaws are generally removed. Feet are small, round and tight. Nails are short, strong and black.

Hindquarters

The hindquarters appear slightly lighter than the forequarters, but are well muscled, and in balance with the front. The hocks are well let down and the stifles are well bent. Extreme angulation is to be penalized. From the rear, the legs extend straight down from the hip through the hock to the feet. Dewclaws must be removed.

Coat

Pattern—The adult coat is highly characteristic and must include several distinct lengths growing naturally in a specific pattern. The coat is short on the face, ears, front of the forelegs and on the hocks; it is medium length on the body, and longer in the ruff, cape, jabot and culottes. The ruff begins in back of the ears and extends completely around the neck; the cape forms an additional distinct layer extending beyond the ruff; the jabot extends across the chest and down between the front legs. The hair down the middle of the back, starting just behind the cape and continuing over the rump, lies flat. It is slightly shorter than the cape but longer than the hair on the sides of the body and sides of the legs. The coat on the rear of the thighs forms culottes, which should be as long as the ruff. Lack of differentiation in coat lengths should be heavily penalized, as it is an essential breed characteristic.

Texture--The coat is abundant, straight and slightly harsh to the touch. The softer undercoat is dense and short on the body and is very dense around the neck, making the ruff stand out. Silky coats, body coats over three inches in length or very short harsh coats are equally incorrect.

Trimming--As the Schipperke is a natural breed, only trimming of the whiskers and the hair between the pads of the feet is optional. Any other trimming must not be done.

Color

The outer coat must be black. Any color other than a natural black is a disqualification. The undercoat, however, may be slightly lighter. During the

shedding period, the coat might take on a transitory reddish cast, which is to be penalized to the degree that it detracts from the overall black appearance of the dog. Graying due to age (seven years or older) or occasional white hairs should not be penalized.

Gait

Proper Schipperke movement is a smooth, well coordinated and graceful trot (basically double tracking at a moderate speed), with a tendency to gradually converge toward the center of balance beneath the dog as speed increases. Front and rear must be in perfect balance with good reach in front and drive in the rear. The topline remains level or slightly sloping downward from the shoulders to the rump. Viewed from the front, the elbows remain close to the body. The legs form a straight line from the shoulders through the elbows to the toes, with the feet pointing straight ahead. From the rear, the legs form a straight line from the hip through the hocks to the pads, with the feet pointing straight ahead.

Temperament

The Schipperke is curious, interested in everything around him, and is an excellent and faithful little watchdog. He is reserved with strangers and ready to protect his family and property if necessary. He displays a confident and independent personality, reflecting the breed's original purpose as watchdog and hunter of vermin.

DISQUALIFICATION

A drop ear or ears. Any color other than a natural black.

- 1. Entries must reach the Show Secretary, Sharon Licciardi, 38512 12th St E, Palmdale, CA 93550, by NOON WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 12, 2000. Fees must accompany entries. This club and/or its superintendent assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner. This club and its superintendent assume no responsibility for the owner or owner's agents entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete, or for entering the same dog twice.
- 2. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks for the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. The returned check **must be made good** by cash or money order **before** the dog will be allowed in the ring.
- 3. Exhibitors' Identification tickets and judging programs will be mailed to the address given on the entry blank. If not received within a reasonable time prior to the show, notify the secretary. Tickets returned by the Post Office marked 'undeliverable' will be held by the Secretary.
- 4. During the hours of judging owners are to be on call, and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly, in order that the judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owners of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. This means it is not the responsibility of the ring steward, nor of any agent of the show-giving club to locate any dog, its owner or handler, when the dog's presence is needed in a judging ring. It should be understood by every exhibitor and handler that waiting for dogs to be brought into the ring is a courtesy extended to the owner or handler of the dog. There is no rule of this club nor of The AKC that requires a judge to wait for an owner or handler to bring his dog into the ring. Show hours 8am-8 pm.
- 5. Trophies and prizes will be awarded in the judging rings to the person exhibiting the dog, who is considered to be the owner or agent of the owner. All claims for trophies and prizes must be made in the judging ring before the completion of judging the breed. Notify the secretary of any discrepancy. No trophies or prizes will be mailed.
- 6. Exhibitors are admonished to make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this premium list. Rule books are available at the Secretary's table at the show or may be obtained from the AKC,5580 Centerview Dr., Raleigh, NC 27606.
- 7. The club, its superintendents or their employees will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, whether the result of accident or other causes and in addition assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by an exhibitor or handler. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
- 8. No grooming tables, pens or exhibitors setups will be allowed in the aisles and all grooming must be done away from the judging ring in areas specified by the club.
- 9. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Bench Show Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for duplicate entry.
 10. There is no provision offered for un-entered dogs at this show.
- 11. Declination of Entries. Southern California Schipperke Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Kennel Club or any official thereof.
- 12. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
- 13. Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles.
- 14: A Recording Fee of 50¢ will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. This Recording Fee is to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the AKC. If a dog is entered in more than one class at the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2).
- 15. Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed Competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one half hour prior to the start of the earliest Conformation judging at the Show. 16. Cleaning up after Your Dogs Is Your Responsibility If your dog soils the grounds it is your responsibility to clean it up. By signing the entry form at this dog show you are agreeing that clean up is your responsibility.
