#### **MEET OUR JUDGES**



#### MARTHA M. OLMOS-OLLIVIER

Mrs. Olmos-Ollivier was raised in Texas and received her first purebred dog - a Chow-when she graduated from High School. She is a retired educator with a BS from the University of New Mexico, and is presently living in California.

During her 40 years in dogs she has bred, owned and shown over 30 champion Pekingese (five of which were Best in Show dogs), and has owned a BIS Champion Kerry Blue, four Champion Parti-Color Cockers and a Champion Wire Fox Terrier.

In their kennel (co-owned with her sister, Mrs. Patricia Miller), they have had Lhasas, Italian Greyhounds, Norwich Terriers and a Miniature Schnauzer at one time or another.

She began judging dogs in 1960 and now judges all Toys, all Non-Sporting, all Terriers, nine Hounds and 15 Sporting breeds and has judged all over the world and most major U.S. shows.

Twenty-five years ago she founded the Long Beach Kennel Club (now considered a top show in Southern California), serving as Secretary. She is also a Board Member of the Toy Breeders Association of Southern California, a recently approved Group Show Club.



#### MRS. PAULINE ANDRUS

I started in obedience in 1967 when an Irish Setter came into my life. She was wild! My husband, Larry said, "She needs obedience training!" That experience changed our lives. Larry trained that dog and I wanted my own to train so we got another one. I trained and showed her to a UD. Over the next years we had several Irish Setters with many obedience titles. Around that time Larry & I started judging obedience. When I lost my last Irish Setter I wanted a Golden Retriever. He was that once in a lifetime dog. He did great as a special in conformation and I put obedience titles on him. We've had Goldens for many years. I am currently training a Golden in obedience and

rally. I also have an Australian Shepherd that is retired. I love everything about the sport of dogs and watching the special relationship handlers have with their dogs in obedience and rally.



#### MR. BURTON J. YAMADA

My wife, Ellen and I started in dogs with the purchase of a pet for our children in 1967. We got the last puppy from a pet litter of Standard Schnauzers and Heidi became our first charmpion and obedience dog. She later became the top producing brood bitch in the breed with 20 Champions, a record that held until a few years ago. We consider ourselves very lucky because we had an excellent start in dogs due to her quality background.

I sta rted showing in Obedience in 1968 and was encouraged to show in conformation, too. Heic∎i finished her CD in a few shows and her Championship in 12 shows in spite of her

novice owner's grooming a nd handling. This meant a lot to us because I was just learning to handle and Ellen was learning to groom and we fi nished with 4 majors. Since that time, almost all of our 75 champions have been owner handled to their titles and ≥5 of them finished from the Bred by Exhibitor class. I encourage and help other novice owners Junior Showmans in pexhibitors to do the same.

I first started judging in 19-89 with 5 breeds: Standard Schnauzer, Miniature Schnauzer, Giant Schnauzer, Great Dane and Akita. A few years later, I was licensed to judge the Working Group, Junior Showmanship, and Best in Show. As a judge, I have terraveled all over the USA, judged internationally and enjoy it all. I have been honored to be asked to judge at Westmanister five times, doing the Junior Showmanship Preliminaries and some breeds in 1997, some breeds and the Working Group in 2003 and Best in Show in 2004. I will again be judging some breeds in 2008. The Westminster "Best in Show" resulted in interviews on ABC, HBO, ESPN and I was named ABC's "Person of the Week" on the Peter Jennimgs Show. I also judged working breeds at the AKC National Invitational in 2003.

Internationally, I have judgeed All Breeds in Japan (Chiba and Okayama), Taiwan (Taipei three times), Costa Rica (San Jose two times), Aus -tralia (Melbourne and Sydney), Shanghai, China, Mexico City, Mexico and Italy (Purina Breeder's Cup Show in Cre -mona and Pavia). I've thoroughly enjoyed judging and seeing the dogs in other countries, especially the dogs we do menot see in the USA. My wife and I have two children, a daughter Michele, a dentist in San Diego and a son, Bradford , a partner of Argos Wealth Advisors LLC.

#### \*\*\* LUNCH BREAK TO FOLLOWING OBEDIENCE \*\*\*

- TRANSFER TO BEST OF BREED COMPETITION Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed Competition, provided this transfer is made to the Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of the earliest Conformation judging at the Show.
- JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP TRANSFERS Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made to the Show Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of the earliest conformation judging or one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of Jr Showmanship judging at the Show, whichever is earlier.
- OBEDIENCE AND RALLY MOVE-UPS Dogs which according to their owners' records have earned an obedience title after the closing of entries for the show may be moved up to the next class, provided this transfer is made in writing and presented to the Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Move-ups may be approved, provided the next level class and judge are available and the class has not reached its limit.

#### NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS AND HANDLERS

TWO WHEELED SCOOTERS, motorized or other, are not allowed on the Fairgrounds. FOR YOUR SAFETY, NO STROLLERS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE JUDGING BUILDINGS. NO DOGS IN RESTROOMS

NO DOGS ARE TO BE LEFT OVERNIGHT IN ANY BUILDING

- DOGS LEFT IN UNATTENDED VEHICLES in warm weather can suffer greatly from heat and may even die from heat prostration. ## NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES \*VETERAN DOGS \*VETERAN BITCHES

(For dogs or bitches seven (7) years of age and older)

\*Chapter 11, Section 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a neutered male may be entered as a Veteran Dog in the Veteran Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Veteran Bitch in the Veteran Bitch Class."

#### BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered in this competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owners' records.

#### JUDGE'S SELECT AWARD

A Judge may, at his/her discretion, present a Judge's Select Award to those quality dogs he/she feels are worthy of final consideration in Best of Breed. Judge's Select Award winners will receive a three streamer rosette in Belgian colors of black, yellow & red. The number of these awards is determined by the number of dogs actually competing in the ring: 1 - 5 = 1 6 - 10 = 2 11 - 15 = 3 16 - 20 = 4 21 - or more = 5

#### NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

- \*STUD DOG CLASS For Stud Dogs and two Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes. Or if a Champion of Record, in the Best of Breed Competition, but MUST be entered in the Stud Dog Class, the Get MUST be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get.
- \*BROOD BITCH CLASS Same as for the Stud Dog Class except substitute "Brood Bitch" for "Stud Dog" and "Produce" for "Get."
- \*Chapter 11, Section 8 of the \*Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."
- BRACE CLASS A brace is defined as two dogs of the same recognized breed that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. The entry form for each dog entered as part of a brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space for Additional Classes "Brace Class".
- TEAM CLASS A team is defined as four dogs of the same recognized breed that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of four handlers. All dogs competing in team competition must have at least one common owner. The entry form for each dog entered as part of a team MUST be marked accordingly in the space for Additional Classes "Team Class".

NOVICE CLASS: This shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three first place awards in a Novice Class in a licensed or member show, with competition present. The winner of a Novice Class shall automatically become eligible, upon notice to the Open Class ring steward, to enter and compete in the Open Class at the same show provided the win is the third (3rd) first place award with competition and further providing there are one or more Junior Handlers competing in the Open Class.

Each dog handled in a regular Junior Showmanship Class must be entered in one of the Breed or Obedience Classes at the show, or must be entered for Junior Showmanship only. However, a dog may be substituted. Such substitution must be accompanied by an official AKC entry form. All such substitution must be made one half-hour prior to the judging of any Junior Showmanship Classes at the show. Each dog must be owned or co-owned by the Junior Handler's father, mother, brother, sister, uncle, aunt, grandfather, grandmother, including step and half relations or by a member of the Junior Handler's household. Every dog entered for Junior Showmanship must be eligible to compete in AKC Dog Shows or Obedience Trials. Bitches in season are not eligible to compete.

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class, with competition present, after the closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made by the Superintendent /Event Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any regular conformation judging or one half-hour prior to the start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show, whichever is earlier.

Winning of first place in an Open Class at this show may qualify or count toward qualification for entry in certain future limited Junior Showmanship Classes. #### ADDITIONAL RULES

- 1. Entries must reach the Show Secretary, Sharon Licciardi, 38512 12th St E, Palmdale, CA 93550, by NOON (PST) WEDNESDAY, January 9, 2008. Fees should accompany entries. This club and/or its secretary assumes no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner. This club and its secretary assume no responsibility for the owner or owner's agents entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete, or for entering the same dog being.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The club will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks for the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. The returned check must be made good by cash or money order before the dog will be allowed in the ring.
- 3. Exhibitors' Identification tickets and judging programs will be mailed to the address given on the entry blank. If not received within a reasonable time prior to the show, notify the secretary. Tickets returned by the Post Office marked 'undeliverable' will be held by the Secretary.
- 4. During the hours of judging owners are to be on call, and have their dogs ready to bring into the judging ring promptly, in order that the judging will not be delayed. Dogs need only be present for their judging. Dogs not needed for further judging may be excused. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owners of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. This means it is not the responsibility of the ring steward, nor of any agent of the show-giving club to locate any dog, its owner or handler, when the dog's presence is needed in a judging ring. It should be understood by every exhibitor and handler that waiting for dogs to be brought into the ring is a courtesy extended to the owner or handler of the dog. There is no rule of this club nor of The AKC that requires a judge to wait for an owner or handler to bring his dog into the ring. Show hours 8am-8am
- 5. Trophies and prizes will be awarded in the judging rings to the person exhibiting the dog, who is considered to be the owner or agent of the owner. All claims for trophies and prizes must be made in the judging ring before the completion of judging the breed. Notify the secretary of any discrepancy. No trophies or prizes will be mailed.
- Exhibitors are admonished to make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this premium list. Rule books are available at the Secretary's table at the show or may be obtained from the AKC, 5580 Centerview Dr. #200, Raleigh, NC 27606.
- 7. The club, its secretary or their employees will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, whether the result of accident or other causes and in addition assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by an exhibitor or handler. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this show is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
- No grooming tables, pens or exhibitors setups will be allowed in the aisles and all grooming must be done away from the judging ring in areas specified by the club.
- 9. Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Bench Show Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for duplicate entry.
- There is no provision offered for un-entered dogs at this show.
- 11. Declination of Entries. The Southern California Schipperke Club may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Kennel Club or any official thereof.
- 12. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.
- 13. Do not leave any dogs in closed vehicles. All persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against the Southern California Schipperke Club, its members or agents, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.
- 14. A Recording Fee of 50¢ and a Event Service Fee of \$1.50 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. These Fees are to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class at the show, the Recording Fee and Event Service Fee are to be collected on the first entry only (AKC Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2).
- 15. Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed Competition, provided this transfer is made by the Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of the earliest Conformation judging at the Show.
- 16. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class after the Closing of entries for a show may transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class provided that this transfer is made to the Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of the earliest conformation judging or one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the Show, whichever is earlier.
- 17. All rights to televise, videotape, advertise, photograph, promote or otherwise exploit this event are vested in the club, or in persons to whom assignments of such rights have been made in writing by the Club. All persons and animals on the show grounds at anytime while the show is in progress, do by attending this show or participating therein, grant to the club the right to photograph, televise, video tape, audiotape or otherwise use their likeness and voice in any manner without further release or consent.
- 18. The club is not responsible for the actions or products of the commercial vendors at this show.
- 19. Dogs which according to their owners' records have earned an obedience or rally title after the closing of entries for the show may be moved up to the next class, provided this transfer is made in writing and presented to the secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.
- 20. The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.
- 21. There shall be no drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.
- All dogs shall be kept on leash except when in the obedience or exercising ring or confined in crates.
- 23. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show.
